### **OUR ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

The following are eligible for admission into the graduate programmes:

- Holders of First Class or Upper Second Class Honors degrees in relevant discipline from recognised universities; or
- Holders of other related qualifications from recognised universities, considered by the Academic Council as equivalent to a First Class or Upper Second Class degree in relevant disciplines; or
- Holders of Lower Second Class degrees plus Postgraduate Diploma/ or should have at least two year's working experience in a relevant working environment.
- The applicant must have obtained the minimum university entry requirement i.e. scored at least a C+ in their KCSE (or its equivalent).
- \* These masters' programmes require at least two years of managerial work experience.

### INTERVIEWS REQUIREMENTS

- Entry to graduate programmes is through a graduate entrance examination (GEE) and an oral interview.
- Interview days are communicated to the applicant once you get in touch with the admissions team.
- An interview fee is applicable and is non-refundable.
- · The applicant is required to provide certified copies of academic certificate(s) and transcripts.
- The applicant also needs to provide two reference letters from academic referees duly filled in; the forms are provided at the time of application.

Kindly note, all other documentation required for admission will be communicated to the applicant prior to attending the interview.
